In order to be eligible to apply for the scholarship an applicant must: 1) Be a U.S. Citizen, in regular admission status as a graduate student. 2) Not necessarily be a Louisiana resident. 3) Not necessarily be a graduate of a Louisiana high school or college/ university. 4) Be enrolled for the semester the student is to receive the funds. 5) First-semester graduate students must have a 3.0 undergraduate cumulative GPA (and satisfactory GRE/GMAT scores). 6) Continuing master's and new doctoral applicants must have at least a 3.5 graduate cumulative GPA to be eligible.
